

# St. John Cemetery

## Rules & Regulations

1. Fresh cut flowers are permitted in an approved vase.
2. No glass jars, tin cans or bottles allowed. They will be removed and disposed of.
3. No artificial flowers permitted from April 1<sup>st</sup> to November 1<sup>st</sup>. Any artificial flowers placed on a grave during this period will be removed and disposed of.
4. Planting of flowers will be permitted but must be centered in front of the grave marker, and not to extend beyond the sides of the marker or one foot beyond the front of the marker.
5. At any time during the year the cemetery reserves the right to remove and dispose of decorations when they become unsightly, or out of control.
6. Only the dwarf yew evergreens are permitted in the cemetery. Please discuss this with the Cemetery Sexton if you are interested in planting them. Approval must be obtained from Cemetery Sexton.
7. Any evergreens or bushes which are not properly maintained or become a problem in the maintenance of the cemetery will be trimmed or removed
8. The cemetery is not responsible for any plantings of any kind in the cemetery.
9. Water is available at the East side of the maintenance building at the rear of the cemetery.
10. Christmas Decorations are permitted November 15<sup>th</sup> - March 1<sup>st</sup>.
11. St. John Cemetery reserves the right to adjust these rules at their discretion.
